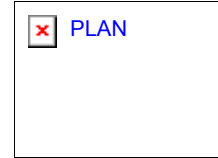

Between Jobs? Serving in the military?

Due to recent fluctuations in the economy, the SECB Board has made allowances for SECB participants between structural engineering positions. Deferred Status for certification is now offered for unemployed participants and also those on active duty.

Starting with the first date a certificant is eligible for recertification and unemployed, any affected certificant is invited to submit his or her Engagement Record and Continuing Education Program Activity Log, along with a letter explaining that he or she is unemployed, plus proof of his or her unemployment status.

Applicants deferred because of unemployment are still required to complete and log at least 5 hours of continuing education. Certificants on active military duty do not need to complete continuing education. 24 months is the maximum a certificant can extend recertification.
