BACKGROUND OF THE STRUCTURAL ENGINEERING CERTIFICATION BOARD

The Structural Engineering Certification Board (SECB) was formed in June of 2004 to serve the public's right to safe, serviceable and sustainable structures, through the establishment and maintenance of a national professional credential of excellence in structural engineering. Structural engineering certification is available only to those structural engineers who demonstrate mastery of the practice of structural engineering through education, experience and examination.

Once certified by the Board of Directors, in order to maintain certification, structural engineers must maintain licensure in a U.S. jurisdiction, must remain in active practice, must remain current in the developing technology of structural engineering practice through continuing education and professional development activities, and must maintain high technical and ethical standards. Structural engineers who obtain and maintain certification are dedicated to high standards of practice.
